



Credits and Exceptions

As well as our **placement exams**, the mathematics department has several options for earning college credit or gaining entry to higher level math courses. These are summarized below.

- **Calculus credit**

Students can earn credits for calculus-level courses as in the table below from Advanced Placement (AP) calculus exams AB or BC, International Baccalaureate Higher Level (IB HL) mathematics exams, and College Level Examination Program (CLEP) calculus exams.

AP BC score	AP AB score	IB HL score	CLEP calculus score	Credits earned
≥ 4	N/A	N/A	N/A	Math 241 and 242
3	≥ 4	≥ 5	≥ 50	Math 241

- **Access to higher level courses**

Students will not get college credit for the scores below in the SAT, ACT, or Advanced Placement AB score, but can gain access to higher-level math courses.

SAT score	ACT score	AP AB score	May enroll in
≥ 700	≥ 31	3	Math 203, 215, or 241
≥ 630	≥ 29	N/A	Math 140 or 203

- **College credit**

A student who scores at least 55 in the CLEP College Mathematics examination will be awarded 3 credits towards graduation. These credits cannot be used to fulfil any general education or major requirements.
